Windows XP Upgrades

WARNING: All of your computers that are using Windows XP need to be upgraded or replaced with Windows 7 or Windows 8.1 computers. (We recommend Windows 8.1)

Microsoft is ending support for Windows XP on April 8th which means there won't be any more security updates for Windows XP from Microsoft. This means that computers using Windows XP will be at risk regardless of what anti-virus system you use.

Typically you can determine what version of Windows you are using by clicking on the Windows "Start" Icon on the task bar, then **right** clicking on the "Computer" or "MyComputer" Option, and then select "Properties". If you have any trouble determining if you are using Window XP, please give us a call, we can help you.
